The Richard C. Longfellow Award is presented in memory of Richard Longfellow who had an outstanding career with Cretex Companies, Inc. Each year, a Concrete Pipe News author is honored with the award for an article that most effectively demonstrates innovative and effective use of concrete pipe.

The Chairman's Safety Award recognizes plants, individuals, and/or companies that have implemented successful safety initiatives resulting in a safer and more productive workplace. The Chairman's Quality Award recognizes plants and/or companies that have implemented successful quality initiatives resulting in a product of repeated excellence.
